2. B. Porter gave an overview of the entering freshman class. There was an increase in admitted students and enrollment this year due to new campus housing. The effect of having a writing evaluation as a part of the SAT was discussed.
3. B. Porter also discussed the new Peoplesoft system for student record keeping. One change with this system is that a student application is considered by a single University of Pittsburgh campus at a given time. However, a student can apply to multiple campuses and the application will be considered sequentially in order of the requested priority.
